

# GUIDELINES and REMINDERS to PARTICIPANTS

Thank you for joining the  $2^{nd}$  Magsaysay Youth Leadership Camp! Help us develop our country's next generation leaders in you and be the person others will want to follow! Congratulations, you are a leader in the making!

Here are some guidelines and reminders for our upcoming Youth Camp:

## **REGISTRATION:**

- Everyone should have registered online thru www.magsaysaywecare.com.
- ❖ Payments can be made at either the Cashier's Office or thru payment deposit to Homer's bank account. Please present your Official Receipts or validated Deposit Slips upon on-site registration on Day 1 for confirmation of your payment.
- ❖ Your parent / guardian should sign a WAIVER that you will submit to me on May 20. The form is included in this announcement.

### **SCHEDULES:**

- ❖ Please comply with the camp schedule. Please refer to Program\_2<sup>nd</sup> MagLead Youth Camp for detailed itinerary of our activities.
- ❖ Meeting place is at Sun Cruises Ticketing Office, CCP Bay Terminal, CCP Complex. You should be there as early as 6:00 am. Boarding time is 7:00 am. The ferry leaves at exactly 8:00 am. No second trip.
- ❖ Your parents are encouraged to attend our Closing Ceremonies on Day 3, May 22. They may avail of the discounted Corregidor Day Tour at P1,290 only. Please let me know who's coming so we can arrange their bookings.

## LODGING

- ❖ Everyone will be booked at Corregidor Hostel from May 20-22.
- There will be separate rooms for Male and Female.

## THINGS TO BRING:

- Comfortable casual wear for the learning sessions (i.e. jeans, jogging pants esp. for team building game, shirts, sandals, rubber shoes) good for 3 days. NO "revealing" clothes please, like skimpy shorts, micro minis, plunging necklines, etc.
- ❖ Beddings and towels are provided at the hostel, but you may bring your own if you want.

- ❖ Meals will be provided during the 3-day camp but you may bring snacks, bottled water, drinks (nothing alcoholic please) if you want. You may also bring your own tumblers for your own refill of drinking water.

- ❖ Take own responsibility for your valuables. The Organizers will not be responsible for the loss of any personal belongings during the duration of the event.

### **CREATIVE TRACKS:**

- ❖ Enrollment in the creative track classes is on a first come-first served basis. The Organizers reserves the right to rearrange the class size based on your enrolment.
- The main requirement for the tracks is your interest and potential for the sessions.
